1 Giving a favor to your guests is the perfect way to say 'Thank You'.

6 When thinking about your favors, remember that they will be part of your decor. Whether they're in place at the guests table on a special table as guests walk into your venue... dream about how giving out your favors can enhance the decor, and how the display can entice your guests.

7 If children invited to your event, have their own seats - the favor you give them needs to be age appropriate.

8 Remember your vendors! It is always nice to add a favor to the final payment for them... they deserve it too, and everyone loves an extra treat!

9 Along with your favor matching the theme of your wedding, be creative and match your favor to you and your fiance's personal style. Try and choose something that has a special meaning to your relationship; ie. If you met at a coffee shop, give coffee beans!
